

USIDNET Publication Policy

Intent to Publish: Notification to USIDNET

(Prior to Submission)

Before submitting an abstract or manuscript for an investigation using registry data, please notify USIDNET at contact@usidnet.org. We ask that you include a copy of your abstract or manuscript, your intended date of submission, and the meeting or journal to which you plan to submit. In certain cases, the USIDNET Steering Committee may wish to add additional comments about the nature of the data and the types of conclusions that can be drawn prior to submission.

Consortium Acknowledgment

When data in the USIDNET Registry is used in any manner in publications, abstracts, meeting materials, or other forms released to the public, please cite USIDNET with the following language:

The U.S. Immunodeficiency Network (USIDNET), a program of the Immune Deficiency Foundation (IDF), is supported by a cooperative agreement, U24AI86837, from the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID).

Authorship

USIDNET asks that you offer authorship to any enrolling physician who contributed 10% or more of the patients to the dataset you used in your work. From there, you are encouraged to offer authorship to anyone else on the list of contributors who you feel contributed significantly to your work.

Additionally, if it works within the authorship guidelines for your target journal, we request that you include “The USIDNET Consortium” as an author, footnoted to include the remaining contributing physicians.
