In partnership with IDF, USIDNET supports the LeBien Visiting Professor Program. This program encourages teaching hospitals throughout the U.S. to request an expert clinical immunologist to lead Grand Rounds and other educational lectures/sessions at institutions which have less academic exposure to primary immunodeficiency diseases (PI). This is a valuable learning opportunity for interested hospitals to help increase their knowledge of diagnoses and treatments of PI.

This application must be accompanied by a Letter of Request stating your reasons for wanting to participate in the program and how a Visiting Professor may enhance the understanding of PI among your students and clinicians. Please include, either in the letter or separately, a tentative list of planned teaching/clinical activities and requested program dates.

***Please keep in mind this program is only available for teaching hospitals/institutions in the U.S.**

At the end of each visit, the host institution will submit a post-visit evaluation. This evaluation allows USIDNET to document program success and knowledge gained by the awarded institution.
